Dr MIRASOGLU was born in Istanbul in 1978 and completed her Underwater and Hyperbaric Medicine residency training in 2008 at Istanbul University, Istanbul Faculty of Medicine. Since then she has been actively working in the field.

From 2009 to October 2012 she was chief of the Hyperbaric Medicine unit and Wound Care Center at Lutfi Kirdar Research and Training Hospital, Burn and Wound Care Center, after working for the establishment of the Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy Unit.

Since November 2012 she works in Istanbul Faculty of Medicine, Underwater and Hyperbaric Medicine Department, and is responsible for in-patient, out-patient departments and HBOT unit. She is currently Associate professor at the Istanbul Faculty of Medicine, Underwater and Hyperbaric Medicine Department (since 2012; assoc. prof since 2020).

She has done extensive medical consultancy and field work at several projects including:
